Contest Guidelines

- Reported activity/donations must be the work of county Farm Bureau members.
- A record of the activity needs to be kept such as a sign-in sheet for volunteers to track hours or a receipt captured for donating money.
- Farm Bureau volunteers at an event should be made aware that they are participating in a county Farm Bureau sponsored Harvest for All activity or event.
- Prize money must be donated to a local food bank affiliated with Feeding America/America's Second Harvest. Please see our website (www.michfb.com/harvest) for a list of affiliates.
- To be eligible for prize consideration, results must be in MFB home office by **OCTOBER 31, 2018**.
