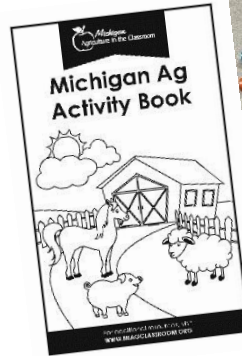


Suggested Resources County FBs Could Provide to Schools
