2025 MASON COUNTY FARM BUREAU \$750.00 SCHOLARSHIP

The Mason County Farm Bureau will award a \$750.00 scholarship annually to a Mason County resident who is enrolled in a post high school program (college or trade school).

ELIGIBILITY

- The scholarship is available to any Regular or Associate member of the Mason County Farm Bureau or their children who are attending a post high school institution.
- Applicant must be pursuing a major in agriculture, horticulture, or related fields.
- Priority consideration will be given to first time recipients, however, repeat recipients are eligible.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- 1. Applicant will fill out the appropriate application along with a 500-minimum word essay explaining why the applicant has chosen a career path in the agricultural or horticultural industries and what impact he/she hopes to have on that industry.
- 2. Applicant will be asked to list his/her major.
- 3. Application will include his/her name, address, phone number, email address. If applicant is a minor, the application will also include parents' information.
- 4. The name of the eligible Farm Bureau member must be included, along with Michigan Farm Bureau member number.
- 5. If applicant is a high school student, he/she will include his/her current high school.
- 6. Applicant will include which college(s) he/she plans to attend or is attending.

Application Deadline: April 1st

Judging:

The Mason County Farm Bureau board or a committee selected by the President will consider the applications and reward one scholarship based on unanimous consent. Applications will be decided in April with board approval during its May meeting.

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Dispersement:

Dispersement will be awarded based on the completion of one semester of studies at a college or trade school. Proof of completion must be submitted to the Mason County Farm Bureau. This may include a transcript, report card, or a letter from a school administrator.
