

# 2025 Scholarship

### **Purpose:**

It is a goal of the Clinton County Farm Bureau to support the industry of Agriculture, including the education of students for future careers in our industry. Financial support for students pursuing careers in agricultural related occupations is a planned annual effort of our organization. Therefore, the Clinton County Farm Bureau has developed the following scholarship program.

### **Scholarship Information:**

Total amount that will be awarded is \$4,000 per calendar year.

### **Eligibility:**

- Applicant must be from a Clinton County Farm Bureau member family.
- Applicant must be pursuing a 2-year or 4-year degree program in an agricultural related field with the intent of a lifelong career in agriculture.
- Applicant must be entering or enrolled the 1st or 2nd year of study and in good standing at a college, university, or technical school as of September 1, 2025.
- Applicant must be able to attend the Clinton County Farm Bureau Annual meeting (date TBD, will be later summer or early fall 2025.)

#### **Application Process:**

- Applicants must complete the attached application form.
- Summary & essay, transcript, and letter of recommendation must be submitted with the application form.
- Applicants must submit their application by April 1, 2025, to clintoncounty@ctyfb.com.

### Award process:

- Scholarship winners will be notified by May 16, 2025.
- A scholarship check will be processed directly to the institution of study only after the submission of a paid registration receipt from an accredited institution.
- Each scholarship recipient chosen will be granted a one-year regular membership into Clinton County Farm Bureau where they will be able to serve on the Young Farmer Committee.

  awards as a member of Farm Bureau, 4-H, FFA or other agriculture related groups.
- Submit a summary, typed not to exceed one page of your involvement with school organizations. Please include any teamwork, leadership roles, volunteer work, honors, and awards.
- Submit an essay, typed not to exceed 150 words, in response to this question: How has agriculture impacted your life thus far.

Only information submitted with this application, along with the required attachments will be considered in the judging of applications submitted.
