

### **Bonnie Vasold Memorial Scholarship**



Saginaw County Farm Bureau is proud to offer a scholarship honoring the spirit of volunteerism set forth by long-time member Bonnie Vasold, who passed away in November 2013. She served on the county Farm Bureau board and on numerous committees, all while continuing to volunteer with other community groups as well. Bonnie's dedication will live on through the organizations she helped shape.

Saginaw County Farm Bureau offers an annual \$1,000 academic scholarship. Applicants do not have to be first-year college students. To be eligible applicants must:

- Be attending or planning to attend an educational facility in pursuit of a degree in agriculture or an agricultural-related program.
- Possess a minimum 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale (if a current student).
- Be a Saginaw County resident.
- Be a U.S. citizen.

The scholarship will be made payable directly to the educational facility. The scholarship must be used in the immediate upcoming school year for tuition, books, room & board, or other necessary tools. No scholarship will be awarded if there are no eligible applicants. A student may only receive the scholarship once but may re-apply each year if not previously selected. All applicants who meet the criteria will be considered, with emphasis on volunteerism.

- ✓ Most recent school transcript (if current student)
